BREWSMITH BEER

CASK.....

Brewsmith APA (5%) Medium bodied, refreshing & hoppy US pale ale with passion fruit, citrus & pine flavours using American hops.

Brewsmith Citra Pale (4.2%) Our classic pale ale malt bill, this time with lashings of lemon and lime from US Citra hops.

New Hop... Who Dis - Talus Edition (3.8%) Our Ultra Pale grist with a touch of wheat. Subtle pine and resin flavours give way to floral and coconut aromas.

Oatmeal Stout (5.2%) Full bodied, richly textured stout. Balanced bitterness with coffee, liquorice, blackcurrant & citrus aromas.

KEG.....
 Five a Day IPA (6.0%) Pale Gold IPA with Ekuano, Mosaic, Citra and Comet hops. Blueberry, Tropical Fruit and Citrus flavours.

Brewsmith x Marble Head Heart and Hands (5.8%)

Collaboration with Marble Beers. West Coast IPA with Amarillo and Motueka hops. Citrus, peach and grapefruit.

BRIGHTSIDE BREWING CO.

CASK.....

Amarillo IPA (5.0%) A light amber American-style IPA, liberally hopped & dry hopped without being overwhelmingly bitter.

Early Doors Bitter (4.0%) A coppery coloured session beer with a sturdy, rich malty core, with hops used to tighten up the palate, and freshen up the finish.

Hopp'd Pale (4.8%) A deliciously vibrant pale, brewed using Styrian Wolf and Huel Melon hops. These European hops are intensely flavoured, offering a gradation of flavour sometimes lacking in New World varieties.

Odin Blonde Ale (3.8%) A fresh, light bodied pale blonde ale brewed with Czech Saaz and US Amarillo hops, together with rising stars from New Zealand.

A fruity, citrus flavour and moderately bitter finish.

Photophobic Stout (5.0%) Intensely coloured stout

inspired by species in low light conditions. A delicious mixture of roasted coffee beans and charred wood smoke aromas, and a full flavoured finish.

KEG.....

Bright Cider (4.5%) A medium sweet cider bursting with fresh, ripe, Devon apple character. Juicy and mouth-watering, leaving a long-lingering apple flavour.

Freyja Pale (3.8%) The newest incarnation of Odin, our best selling blonde. It's stepped up by heavily dry hopping it in the FV with Amarillo and Citra pellets to super enhance what drinkers love about the beer.

Helles Lager (4.8%) Made with classic European hops. Straw coloured with very mild bitterness, a clean and fresh taste, and delicate hop aromas & flavours.

IPA (5.0%) A weighty, mid-amber IPA brewed with Summit, Simcoe

and Nelson Sauvin, then dry hopped with Mosaic and Amarillo. Citrus & tropical fruit hop characteristics, with a crisp bitter finish.

DEEPLY VALE BREWERY

Citra Storm (4%) Pale ale brewed using Citra hops offering a revitalising drinking experience. Session ale with flavours and scents of lemon and grapefruit.


DV8 (4.8%) Multi award winning breakfast stout with a rich & creamy texture that's sure to satisfy. Delicious smooth drinking.


DV US (3.8%) Light golden session ale made with Columbus, Centennial and Cascade hops. Delivers a mix of tastes with a hint of peaches in the background.

Equilibrium (3.8%) Harmoniously balanced session ale. Light in hue with a malty foundation, complemented by bitterness that enhances its scent.

Optimum (4.2%) A classic golden best bitter, crafted using

the highest quality malt and hops, resulting in a well-balanced taste. Features a gratifying bitterness, a hint of caramel, and a delicate tropical fruit aroma.


 **Rocket Man IPA** (5.3%) Dry-hopped with Equanot, Rocket Man takes your taste buds on a joyride through zesty citrus galaxies and herbaceous star clusters.

 **Salty Dog** (5.2%) A very special salt-ed caramel Stout. Tasting notes don't do it justice, get yourself a glass!

 **White Wolf** (3.8%) An extra pale ale brewed with Styrian Wolf hops, imparting a flavour of mango, passionfruit, and lemongrass. A refreshing well-balanced session ale.

CASK (ON THE STANLEY BAR)

 **Citra Pale Ale** (4.2%) Solid modern citrus pale made from Pale Malt and solid amount of Citra hops. Clean and Crisp.

 **Traditional Pale Bitter** (3.6%) Solid Trad style ale made from Pale Malt and Fuggins and Citra hops. Clean and Crisp.

 **Traditional Amber Bitter** (4.0%) Easy drinking and smooth best bitter with balanced malt, fruit & hop flavours. Clean & Crisp.

KEG (ON JUGGERNAUT'S BAR)


 **MunichBacher "The Cosmos of All Creation"** (4.4%) Easy drinking, crisp and fresh.

Brewed with Mandarina Bavaria and Citra hops, providing a fruity, refreshing flavour and aroma. A properly fermented Pilsner.

 **Hazy Pale Ale "The First Juggernaut..."** (3.6%) Easy drinking, crisp and fresh. Brewed with loads of Pale Malt, Citra hops and more Citra Cyro for a powerful taste.


 **Hazy NEIPA "The Wizard"** (4.4%) New England IPA, fresh and fruity. Double dry hopped with a big payload of juicy Citra and Mosaic hops for a powerful taste.

MARBLE BREWERY

 **American Pilsner** (4.2%) Crisp, clean and drinkable with notes of citrus, pine & caramel.

 **Berimbolo** (4.5%) This dry hopped blonde ale features


Enigma hops backed up by Amarillo and Mosaic. Tropical, berry and citrus aromas sit on a soft base, with the bitterness dialled back.

 **Brick By Brick** (4.8%) Caramel maltyness with notes of toffee offers the perfect foundation for layers of flavour to be built brick by brick. Marmalade and herbal notes are balanced with a moreish and rounded finish.

 **Floraison** (4.2%) Brewed with our friends Farm Yard Brew Co. We created this farmhouse pale, adding citrus and a little spice to create the perfect session beer

 **Lemon & Bergamot Witbier** (5.1%) Blends zingy lemon with

fresh Bergamot for a cacophony of citrus notes and delivers perfect refreshment. A collaboration with North Riding Brewery

 **Pint** (3.4%) Session ale is brewed with an all pale malt bill, with a blend of modern and exciting hops. Our benchmark beer promises a burst of zesty aromas, uplifting grapefruit flavours and a subtle lemongrass finish.

NORTHERN MONKEY


CASK

 **Dirty Harry** (4.5%) Deep amber ale with a complex malty back bone, hopped with Cascade.

 **Supera Moras** (3.8%) English pale ale single hopped with Olicana, giving soft passionfruit flavours on a biscuit malt base.

KEG

 **Boats n Hose** (6.2%) Pale DDH hopped with Citra boasting big hits of Citrus, melon and pineapple.


 **Funky Monkey** (5.5%) American IPA with a big and bold hop profile, subtle grapefruit and orange flavours.

 **Happy Go Lucky** (5%) DDH Talus pale with hits of pink grapefruit, guava and tropical fruits.


 **Helles Lager** (4%) Crisp and clean with slight hoppy finish.


NORTHERN WHISPER

CASK

 **Beltie** (4.8%) Stout. Big and bold using four different malts, hopped with Northdown & Target.

 **Blimey** (3.8%) Classic British bitter hopped with Bramling Cross.

 **Gander** (3.9%) British pale ale. Super quaffable ultra pale hopped with Olicana.

 **Yammerhouse** (4.5%) American pale ale. Pithy Orange, lemon and lime flavours, Hopped with Amarillo, Equanot and Mosaic

KEG

 **Chinwag** (5.6%) IPA. Flavours of Mango, pine, Citrus & Tropical aromas from Citra & Mosaic hops.

 **Helles Lager** (4%) A classic crisp clean Lager with delicate hop flavour from Tettnanger and hallertau tradition.

 **Steady Eddie** (3.8%) Pale ale with uicy Peach, Apricot and Lemon flavours.

RED ROSE

 **Bowley Bitter - Traditional Northern Bitter** (3.7%) Dark

ish, malty yet sharp with a hoppy citrus finish. Roasted flavour with a big taste for such a light ABV.

RED ROSE CONTINUED

Buy Polar - Modern Pale Ale (3.8%) A very drinkable modern pale ale, showcasing CFI62 from Charles Faram's hop development programme. Hints of grapefruit, lime and citrus shine through the carefully selected blend of pale malts.

Czeckmate - Most pale ale (3.8%) A most delightful very pale ale! Strawberry and bubblegum aroma with grapefruit and pineapple citrus flavour.

Gladrags - Earnestly Pale Ale (4.1%) A very drinkable refreshing pale ale. Made with Ernest hops.

Likely More Bar Tat - That'll do for an IPA (6.1%) Full strength IPA using British Olicana hops. Long lasting hoppy aroma and after-taste. Good bitterness and does not lie about it's strength.

Mystick - Brilliantly Blonde Beer (3.9%) Made using Mystic hops. Hints of citrus, blackcurrant and passionfruit. An easy-going session strength blonde beer.

Paddy O'Hacker's Genuine Irish Stout Brewed in Lancashire (4.6%) Thick, black and a creamy head. Roast barley flavour with a hint of bitterness. Massive barley aroma and a nice chewy fullness on the palate.

Treacle Miner's Tipple - Mildly Amusing Dark Mild (3.6%) Very Northern character, intensely dark traditional best mild. Sweetish and liquoricy, with more body than a standard mild. Bitterness comes through in the lasting aftertaste.

STRANGE TIMES BREWING CO.

Coyote American Pale Ale (4.5%) The trickster Spirit! Hoppy, pale and citrusy, there's more to this APA than meets the eye.

Mad King Sweeney Irish Red Ale (4.6%) Malty, smooth, roast caramel flavours. Rye & oats make our red ale balanced enough to calm the mad king himself.

Neo Kosmo Blond (4.1%) Hoppy, fresh, reasonably bitter, bursting with the citrusy freshness of New World hops.

Lorelei Lager (4.2%) Light, refreshing and flavourful.

Memento Mori IPA (5.5%) Strong, hoppy and bitter.

Revenant Stout (4.8%) Roast barley provides depth of colour & flavour. Oats, chocolate & rye give a velvety finish.

New World Red Ale (4.8%) Red Ale made with five malts and hopped with Centennial, Nelson Sauvin and Columbus.

Lycan Ipa (6%) Hazy like a West but juicy like an East Coast hopped with Simcoe, Citra & Mosaic.
